

# MARAL - DEER

## FASCINATION „HUNTING IN KAZAKHSTAN“

After Russia and China, Kazakhstan is the largest Country of Eurasia. If you place a geographical map of Kazakhstan in front of you and let it “talk” to you, you will learn little and at the same time lots about this vast country. Almost the whole area is covered with the yellow of the steppe mountains, deserts and semi-deserts, only in the southern and eastern border regions you will see the high mountain ranges, but rather tiny compared to the yellow areas that appear on your map.

The Maral lives in mountains of the Eastern Tianshan, in the Kazakh mountains Dzungar - Alatau, Tarbagatai and the Saur mountains, in the Altai, in the Salair back and Kuznetsk - Alatau mountains, in the Sayan - Mountains and its foothills, as well as in the Baikal area. In the field of CIS, the total amount of Maral deer is estimated to be about 80 000 pieces.

The main rutting season of the Maral deer in almost areas of Kazakhstan as far as the Sajjan mountain range is usually into the second half of September. The total rutting period is from September to the beginning of October, during this period especially, hunting will be done via call.

The Maral grounds are extensive in Kazakhstan. The trophy quality, especially in the Dzungar - Alatau mountain range is excellent. Maral carry between 10 to 16 - 17 kg antler weight. The hunt with the Maral whistle is similar to the one in the Altai and Sajjan mountains. Hunting season is from the middle of September to the middle of October. Accommodation is usually in log cabins, tents or yurts. Hunting will commence with aid of horses and via stalking at a mountain height of between 1000 to 2.500 m height. In addition, or in combination Siberian deer, Siberian Ibex or wolves can also be hunted down.
